- PROMISE = to <u>tell</u> someone that you will <u>certainly</u> do something (From Cambridge Dictionary)



The Right and Duty of Parents Regarding Education (36)

 The task of giving education is rooted in the primary vocation of married couples to <u>participate in God's creative activity (...)</u>

 As the Second Vatican Council recalled, "since parents have conferred life on their children, <u>they have a most solemn</u> <u>obligation to educate their offspring</u>.



- Parents must be acknowledged as the first and foremost educators of their children. Their role as educators is so decisive that <u>scarcely</u> anything can compensate for their failure in it.
- It cannot be forgotten that the most basic element, so basic that it qualifies the educational role of parents, is parental love (...) - Parental love is the norm inspiring and guiding all concrete



The <u>concrete example</u> and <u>living witness</u> of parents is fundamental and irreplaceable in educating their children to pray. <u>Only by praying together with their children</u> can a father and mother (...) penetrate the innermost depths of their children's hearts and <u>leave an impression that the</u> future events in their lives will not be able to efface.

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
Educators in Prayer (60. Continued)

Let us again listen to the appeal made by Paul VI to parents: "Mothers, do you teach your children the Christian prayers? Do you prepare them, in conjunction with the priests, for the sacraments that they receive when they are young: Confession, Communion and Confirmation? Do you encourage them when they are sick to think of Christ suffering to invoke the aid of the Blessed Virgin and the saints Do you say the family rosary together? And you, fathers, do you pray with your children, with the whole domestic community, at least sometimes? Your example of honesty in thought and action, joined to some common prayer, is a lesson for life, an act of worship of singular value. In this way you bring peace to your homes. Remember, it is thus that you build up the Church." (General Audience Address, Aug. 11, 1976)



CONFIRMATION 2023/2024 THE SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

CCC 1285 Baptism, the Eucharist, and the sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the "sacraments of Christian initiation," whose unity must be safeguarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For "by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptised] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed."



CONFIRMATION 2023/2024 THE PERSONS TO BE CONFIRMED (from Canon Law)

Can. 889 §1 Every baptised person who is ne capable of receiving confirmation.

Can. 890 The faithful are bound to receive this sacrament at the proper time. Parents and pastors of souls, especially parish priests, are to see that the faithful are properly instructed to receive the sacrament and come to it at the opportune time.

§1 Every baptised person who is not confirmed, and only such a person, is



CONFIRMATION 2023/2024 SPONSORS (from Canon Law)

Can. 892 As far as possible the person to be confirmed is to have a sponsor. The sponsor's function is to take care that the person confirmed behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfils the duties inherent in this sacrament.

Can. 893 §1 A person who would undertake the office of sponsor must fulfil the conditions mentioned in can. 874 which reads: §1 To be admitted to undertake the office of sponsor, a person must: 1° be appointed by the candidate for baptism, or by the parents or whoever stands in their place (...)to be appointed the person must be suitable for this role and have the intention of fulfilling it; 2° be not less than sixteen years of age 3° be a catholic who has been confirmed and has received the blessed Eucharist and who lives a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken; 4° not labor under a canonical penalty, whether imposed or declared; 5° not be either the father or the mother of the person to be baptised.

§2 It is desirable that the sponsor chosen be the one who undertook this role at baptism.
